

The heart of this dress code is to exemplify modesty. Research shows that students who maintain a higher standard for dress perform better academically. This dress code applies to ANY Calvary Function or Event.

Shoes:	No beach flip flops	No beach flip flops Heels 2" Maximum
Shirts:	Long sleeved or short sleeved. Can be stripes, solids, or patterns. Logos must be discreet (small--less than 2") Calvary shirts may be worn only on school spirit days and special occasions which will be indicated on the school calendar or by Hoodies are allowed in the classroom, at the discretion of staff, and for recess only. Calvary sweatshirts are preferred.	Long sleeved or short sleeved. Can be solids, stripes, or patterns. Logos must be discreet (small--less than 2") Calvary shirts may be worn only on school spirit days and special occasions which will be indicated on the school calendar or by Hoodies are allowed in the classroom, at the discretion of staff, and for recess only. Not Acceptable:	Any shirt that bares the back, shoulders, midriff, or has cut outs. This would include while a student is sitting, standing, or Hoodies or coats in chapel.	
Pants:	Khaki styled pants, colored denim (except blue), or dress slacks that reach the ankles.	Khaki styled pants, colored denim (except blue), or dress slacks that reach the ankles. Leggings are not pants and must have a dress or skirt over them with a
Not Acceptable:	Baggy or skin hugging pants. Keep it loose enough for kids to be able to sit criss-cross without exposing skin or feeling pinched. Pants with holes, stains, rips, or tears.	
Skirts/Dresses:		All dresses or skirts must have a minimum length of 2" above the knee. Sleeveless dresses must be covered with a sweater or jacket. Leggings worn with anything shorter than 2" above the knee.
Not Acceptable:		
Accessories:	All watches, necklaces, earrings, bracelets, and rings must fit so that they won't fall off and/or become distracting to others. Any	Ear piercings only.
Not Acceptable:	Piercings of any kind for boys. Tattoos, temporary or permanent.	
Hair:	Kept above the eyes Above the collar (cultural exceptions are allowed) Natural colors Neatly combed and clean	Kept above the eyes Natural colors (including highlights) Neatly combed and clean
Not Acceptable:	No "designs" or "spikes" may be cut into the hair. Hair dying or streaking in unnatural colors is not allowed.	
P.E.	Applies to both boys and girls: Calvary PE uniform shirt (obtain from the office) or mileage club shirt. Basketball style shorts (mid-thigh or longer) or windpants/sweatpants that are black, gray, or blue.	
Not Acceptable:	Leggings by themselves.
