Two Stories Reveal One Savior

The Centurion and his servant teach us about:

- 1. Love
- 2. Generosity
- 3. Humility (Faith and arrogance cannot coexist.)
- 4. Authority (Submission to authority gives you authority.)
- 5. Faith (Jesus sees faith where we don't always see it.)

The widow and her son teach us about:

- 1. Finality
- 2. Love
- 3. Compassion
- 4. Authority
- 5. Identity

Theological Truths We Must Know

- 1. Distance cannot delay Jesus.
- 2. Disaster cannot deter Jesus.
- 3. Depravity cannot defeat Jesus. (There's a sharp divide between apparent worthiness and actual unworthiness.)

"Sin is not a pet for you to tame. It is a beast that Jesus died to kill." - Philip Nation

4. Death cannot destroy Jesus. (Jesus broke up every funeral He ever attended, including His own.) Jesus is always in authority, even over death.

Personal Decisions I Must Make

- 1. Will I submit to God's authority?
- 2. Will I admit I'm not entitled to grace?

3. Will I look to Christ as my only hope?

On the three crosses of Golgotha, three things stand out:

One died **to** sin. One died **in** sin. One died **for** sin.

4. Will I repent and believe?
