

Knowing the Truth and Missing the Point Luke 7:18-35 Sermon Study Notes

Many people know the truth, they've just missed the point.

We all experience seasons of doubt.

There's one, big, overarching question we all must answer: Who is Jesus?

I. A Question of Style (7:18-23)

John's Question: "Why aren't you acting like the Messiah?"

Jesus' Answer: "Look at what I'm doing."

It's possible to recognize Jesus and revere Scripture but miss the point.

Takeaway: I must recognize who Jesus is because of what He did.

II. A Question of Substance (7:24-30)

Jesus' Question: "What did you go out there to see?"
Jesus' Assertion: "John's no reed shaking in the wind."
It's possible to hear sound preaching but miss the point.

Takeaway: I must receive Jesus as my King because He brings the Kingdom.

III. A Question of Scolding (7:31-35)

Jesus' Question: "What's your problem?"

Jesus' Assessment: "You guys are just a bunch of brats!"

It's possible to look religious but miss the point.

Because of Simplicity

Because of Shallowness

Because of Self-Righteousness

Because of Sin's Grip

When Jesus brings the good news He is bringing judgment.

Takeaway: I must respond to Jesus however He leads rather than telling Him how to leads.

Wisdom is yielding control to the One who's in control anyway.
