Luke 16:19-31

Sermon Study Notes

Money will always seek to master you.

I. The Reality of Injustice in Life (16:19-21)

The rich man spares no expense to ensure his own comfort.

Takeaway: I must care for the poor and oppressed.

II. The Reversal of Status in Death (16:22)

Whatever you achieve, whatever you own, whatever you accomplish, one day someone may talk about it, but then they will note you died.

Takeaway: Death changes everything, so I must live for eternity.

III. The Relegation of Sinners to Hell (16:23)

The decisions you make on earth will determine your destiny for eternity.

Takeaway: I cannot trust in birth, wealth, or religion to keep me out of hell.

IV. The Relentlessness of Torment in Hell (16:23-24)

The justice of God is just as relentless as His grace.

Takeaway: I will either experience the relentlessness of grace or torment.

V. The Recalcitrance of Sinners in Hell (16:24)

Takeaway: My heart will be no different at the end of eternity than it was when I entered eternity.

VI. The Rebellion of Sinners in Hell (16:25-26)

The decisions you make on earth will determine your demeanor for eternity.

Everything you have, you received.

Takeaway: I must repent while there's still time.

VII. The Role of Moses and the Prophets (16:27-29)

Takeaway: I must accept the witness of the Scriptures.

VIII. The Resurrection of One from the Dead (16:30-31)

Takeaway: If I don't believe in the Bible, I won't believe in Jesus either.

One has risen from the dead - have you repented?
